



# SEG Digital Library

The premier applied geophysics collection



Recognizing fiscal challenges faced by institutions worldwide, the Society of Exploration Geophysicists is offering a **10% discount off 2010 rates for the SEG Digital Library** and a **5% discount off 2010 rates for the SEG Research Collection** to institutions that make subscription commitments for three years by 31 December 2009. The Environmental and Engineering Geophysical Society is offering a similar **5% discount for the EEGS Research Collection**. Prices will be fixed through 2012 for subscribers that choose one of these options by the deadline. The offers do not apply to consortia arrangements, for which discounts already are applied, or to subscriptions to single journals or expanded abstracts. They also do not include SEG eBooks, scheduled to launch in early 2010. The SEG packages do include new publications that may be added such as Global Conference Abstracts that are under construction (more later).



### SEG Digital Library [▶ segdl.org](http://segdl.org)

SEG Digital Library subscriptions include four SEG publications and two publications of the Environmental and Engineering Geophysical Society. Access to these publications in a unified interface with a search engine across the collection is available for a single discounted price, reduced and fixed through 2012 for subscribers making a three-year subscription commitment. Each publisher's products are available in separate research collections. The free Digital Cumulative Index, covering five applied geophysics societies' publications, is integrated with the Digital Library.

### SEG Research Collection [▶ segdl.org/segrc](http://segdl.org/segrc)

This collection includes SEG's journals, *GEOPHYSICS* and *THE LEADING EDGE*; the *Encyclopedic Dictionary of Applied Geophysics*, fourth edition; and the SEG Technical Program Expanded Abstracts. The collection is available at a discount off the price of these publications sold separately, reduced and fixed through 2012 for subscribers making a three-year subscription commitment.
