Technical Program Schedule

Searching on your last name will allow you to determine your talk's scheduled Room (SAGEEP 1, SAGEEP 2, SAGEEP 3), Session Name, Session Chair(s), day (Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday) and the start/end times for your 20-minute oral presentation or for the day your poster is scheduled to be available for viewing. Please review the Poster Presentation information below for those who have requested a poster or who selected "let the chair" decide and you do not find your talk title in the oral presentation schedule.

If you have circumstances that require a request to change your designated day/time or session, or if you have received a Letter of Acceptance but do not see your talk or poster title listed, please contact the SAGEEP Planning Committee by sending an email to staff@EEGS.org.

Oral Presentation Requirements

Oral presentations should be PowerPoint files (or a PDF of slides), for a 15-minute presentation with 5 minutes for questions for a total of no more than 20 minutes. You do not need to follow a template for the PowerPoint presentation. You are asked to load your PowerPoint file(s) on a USB drive, which you will transfer to the computer in your session room prior to the beginning of the session. Your Session Chair(s) will be present to assist.

Poster Presentation Information

Posters form a significant and important part of the Technical Program and we are excited to provide a poster presentation format designed to give posters maximum visibility and impact! This year, we are offering poster viewing time each day in the Exhibit Hall, so please plan to be present at coffee breaks and during lunch on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. This year, we are allocating additional time to view posters and speak to authors/presenters on Wednesday at the Wrap-up Reception beginning just after the oral presentations from 3:10 to 4:00 p.m.

The poster boards – two sides - are 4 feet high and 8 feet long (actual space for posters). Presenters can either use Velcro tape or thumb tacks to affix posters to the board. The poster boards will be available in the Exhibit Hall.

On Wednesday, the Exhibit Hall closes at 5:00 p.m. and they begin dismantling the booths. Please be sure to remove your poster from the boards by then if you wish to retrieve it. All posters should be removed by the appointed time or they will be collected and recycled by the staff. Please note that all presentations will be included in the SAGEEP Best Paper Evaluation process.
